Animal Care

This programme aims to prepare you for the world of work in the land based sector. You will gain practical knowledge and experience of the industry whilst studying with skilled staff in a specialist training environment. You can train up to level one standard, as well as improving skills such as communication, team work, leadership, health and safety at work and the use of high quality tools and equipment.

Throughout the course you will be working on a real working farm where you will have the opportunity to cover units on animal care, horticulture, animal grooming and Health and Safety.

Business Administration

The course will be of special interest to those wanting to gain experience in an education setting. This programme offers an individualised curriculum designed to prepare you for the world of work. You will gain practical experience and knowledge of working in the education sector, as well as enhancing your problem-solving,

Learners will gain a Level 1 qualification in Business Administration whilst completing a specialist three-day placement at a reputable organisation in Newcastle.

Teaching Assistant

This course is designed to equip learners with the skills and expertise to support teachers in schools.

Learners will gain a level 1 qualification in Supporting Teaching and Learning within Schools. You will work towards this whilst on placement with one of our local partner schools. You will complete a three or four day placement, learning from education professionals. All learners will come together one day per week at Trinity Academy, to work toward the completion of coursework.

Maths and English

Students can join Functional Skills Maths and English sessions according to their assessed levels. The day would also include a session on Employability Skills.

Trinity Solutions Academy will assess all learners on entry.

Functional Skills Maths and English sessions are timetabled by level.

Entry Level & Level 1	9.30am—2.30pm	Day to be confirmed on joining
Level 2	9.30am—2.30pm	Day to be confirmed on joining

If learners wish to study GCSE this would be a two year commitment and therefore would have to be discussed with the individual establishment.
